Sustainability reporting

Mandatory climate reporting for listed issuers from FY2025 and large non-listed companies from FY2027



Grants to defray cost of preparing sustainability reports:

- SME Sustainability Reporting **Programme**
- Sustainability Reporting Grant

Need for high-quality carbon credits

Complementary measure to support national decarbonisation.



Companies can offset up to 5% of taxable emissions from 2024



Published eligibility criteria and whitelist of carbon crediting methodologies and host countries (carbon markets corporation).

International cooperation on Article 6 credits:

Implementation Agreements with Papua New Guinea and Ghana

Memorandum of Understanding (MOUs) with various countries



Launched the Singapore Carbon Market Alliance (SCMA) to connect Singapore-based businesses and international suppliers with interest in high-quality Article 6 carbon credits.
